PLAYER PROFILE

Sebastian Tolosa-Sarner is a direct, high intensity forward who plays primarily as a striker or centre forward and is equally comfortable across both wings. His game is built on pace in behind, aggressive pressing from the front, physical presence and intelligent movement. He is most dangerous in transition, using his speed to stretch defences and break lines, and he carries a heavy and consistent goal threat. He pairs clean finishing with sharp positioning, strong link up play and a relentless work rate off the ball. This season he has been his team's primary attacking output and a reliable source of goals in the biggest matches.

PLAYING HISTORY

Sebastian began his development in the youth academy of Club Deportivo Universidad Católica in Chile, where he played from ages 9 to 13. After stepping away from academy football he continued to compete in school sport alongside rugby. Following his move to the UK he earned a sports scholarship in both football and rugby, represented his school first teams in both codes and captained the first team, building early leadership experience in a demanding sporting environment. He has since committed fully to football and developed through the University of Bristol BUCS programme, where he is a first team player competing in the highest BUCS division following promotion.

ACADEMIC PROFILE

Sebastian is a strong academic performer reading for a BSc in Economics at the University of Bristol and targeting First Class Honours. He intends to continue into postgraduate study, which maps directly onto a graduate entry route into US collegiate football and strengthens his case for both academic and athletic scholarship support. He is a native English speaker, so no language certification is required.
